

New Delhi, September 11, 2017: With the theme of "Public Affairs: Effective Advocacy & Public Policy Strategies", Public Affairs Forum of India (PAFI) will organize its 4th annual national conference discussing strategies to develop effective advocacy methods and ways and means to engage with stakeholders to build a robust public policy & public affairs programme. This edition of the conference will engage with vital stakeholders across key disciplines to bring together different perspectives in a globally networked and inter-dependent world.

Mr. Vinay Sahasrabuddhe, Member of Parliament & National Vice President, BJP, will over a formal dinner on the 14th September. Mr. Sahasrabuddhe will share his views on the top political issues, performance of the Union Government and domestic and international priorities for next two years. He will also share his thoughts on expectations from public affairs professionals and their roles in advocacy & shaping public policy.

The conference will be inaugurated on 15th Sep. by Mr. Hardeep Singh Puri, Minister of State (Independent Charge), Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Government of India. He will share his views on the role of public affairs in helping the government with efficient policy formulation while ensuring seamless information flow between the government and industry on key policy issues.

The closing session will see Mr. Amitabh Kant, CEO, NITI Aayog, talking about effective advocacy with Government, discussing scope for content-driven public affairs engagement and the role that the industry can play a role in the policy formulation process.

The day-long conference will begin at 9 AM on the 15<sup>th</sup> Sep. and will cover themes like effective advocacy with bureaucracy and the role of public affairs thereof, importance of public affairs as a function and the role that CEOs play, perceptions about advocacy & media and the factor of trust, and public affairs engagement with legislators.

The conference will see thought leaders from the field of Legislature, Bureaucracy, Industry, and Media.
