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Shri Bhupender Yadav ji is the Union Cabinet Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change and a Member of Parliament in the Lok Sabha representing Alwar, Rajasthan. Born in Ajmer on June 30, 1969, he earned his Bachelor of Laws degree from Government College, Ajmer, and began his leadership career as General Secretary of the Akhil Bharatiya Adhivakta Parishad (2000–2009) before taking on key organisational roles in the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) as National Secretary in 2010 and National General Secretary in 2014. A prominent electoral strategist, he served as the BJP's election in-charge for multiple state assembly elections, including Maharashtra (2024), Madhya Pradesh (2023), Manipur (2022), Bihar (2020), Jharkhand (2014), and Rajasthan (2013), as well as the 2019 Lok Sabha elections. Before his election to the Lok Sabha, he represented Rajasthan as a Rajya Sabha MP from 2012 to 2024 and previously served as the Union Minister for Labour and Employment alongside Environment from 2021 to 2024. During his legislative tenure, he chaired numerous high-profile parliamentary, joint, and select committees, including those on the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, the GST Bill, the Financial Resolution and Deposit Insurance Bill, and Personnel, Public Grievances, Law and Justice. He is also an author who co-wrote *The Rise of the BJP* and *Supreme Court on Forest Conservation*, and regularly publishes columns on public policy and national affairs.
