Educational Attainments

Post Graduate Diploma in Management, Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad

(July 1986–March 1988): The first year of study included mandatory courses in the areas of Marketing, Finance and Accountancy, Economics, Mathematics & Statistics, and, Organizational Behaviour. In the Second Year, apart from a few mandatory courses in Business Policy, electives were selected evenly in the areas of economics, finance (including public finance) and marketing.
