Telecom Bill Provides Roadmap for Industry Restructuring: Ashwini Vaishnaw

Telecoms Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said on Thursday that the new telecom law will provide a clear roadmap for industry restructuring and promote innovation.

Speaking at an event of the Public Affairs Forum of India, the minister said that in the next year and a half to two years, the government should be able to implement the full digital regulatory framework, which aims to balance societal objectives. to be completely renewed. duties and rights of individuals, and technological agnostic framework.

"The industry goes through different phases. Sometimes due to business environments, technological changes and all sorts of other factors. There is a need for restructuring. How do you factor that in so that the industry gets a very clear step-by-step plan? If restructuring needs to happen, these are the things that need to be taken care of. These are the things that are my rights, so that kind of clear framework has been put in this bill," Vaishnaw said.

He said the digital world needs a comprehensive set of legislation and the Prime Minister has given the Ministry of Telecom the target that the regulatory framework of India's digital legal framework should be globally benchmarked.

"That doesn't mean we just go around and copy what's best in the world. That means we should strive to create a digital legal framework, that the world should come and study. That's a really big goal, but it is possible," Vaishnaw said. Under the draft

OTT is included in the draft bill as part of the telecommunications service. The cabinet has proposed a provision in the bill to get rid of tariffs and fines for telecom and internet providers.

The ministry has also proposed a provision for reimbursement of fees if a telecom or internet provider surrenders its license.

Vaishnaw said the next 25 years will be a period of inclusive growth and investment will be the main vehicle for growth, focusing on manufacturing, innovation, simplification of rules and reforms in social infrastructure such as education and health care.
