Ashwini Vaishnav said that the digital world needs comprehensive laws and the Prime Minister has targeted the Telecom Ministry to make the regulatory framework of India's digital law at par with global standards.

New Delhi. The new Telecom Bill will pave a clear path for restructuring the industry and promoting innovation. Telecom Minister Ashwini Vaishnav said this on Thursday. He said in an event of 'Public Affairs Forum of India' that in the next one-and-a-half to two years, the government will revamp the entire digital regulatory framework. It aims to strike a balance between social objectives, duties and rights of individuals, technology infrastructure, etc.

Vaishnav said, "Industry passes through various stages. Sometimes due to business environment, technology change and various other factors. Hence there is a need for restructuring. How to include this in the Bill so that the industry gets a very clear

"It doesn't mean that we just go around and copy whatever is best in the world," the minister said. This means that we aim to create a digital legal framework that the world must study. It is a huge goal, but it is possible." According to the draft Telecom Bill-2022, 'over-the-top' apps like WhatsApp, Zoom and Google Duo, which provide calling and messaging services, will be allowed in the country. A license may be required to operate.
