Participating at a Public Affairs Forum of India (PAFI) event, Irani said, "Women fight elections for legislative assemblies as well as panchayats. Politically, 2.8 million women are adept at fighting elections. That is the power of women in our country." 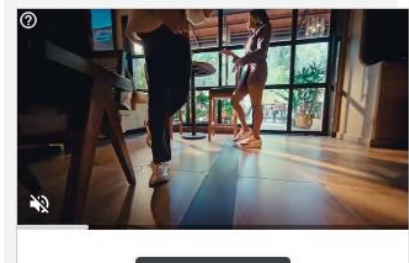

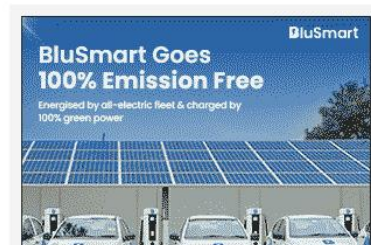

W Delhi, Oct 26 (PTI) Union minster Smriti Irani on Thursday said gender should not be allowed to be used as a shield for corruption as that would be a great disservice to the women who have fought for equality.

The women and child development minister made the remarks while responding to a question in a panel discussion organised by the Public Affairs Forum of India. "The matter is before the ethics committee so it would be unbecoming of me to comment on it but I would say that a distinction has to be made between corruption and the way of life," Irani said.

"In the country, everybody is free to live their life as they so desire but as parliamentarians we have the ethical, moral and legal duty towards the Constitution. So my submission to you as a woman would be that don't allow gender to be used as a shield for corruption then you do a great disservice to the women who have fought for equality," she said without naming Moitra.
