New Delhi: India's take-off moment has arrived, backed by the advantages of having the world's largest working population and resilient physical and digital institutions, NITI Aayog vice chairman Suman Bery said on Wednesday.

Now the onus lies on the private sector to lead the country on a sustainable growth trajectory, he said, urging corporates to enhance investments on research and development.

Speaking at an event on 'India's Amrit Kaal: Implications on the private sector' organised by Public Affairs Forum of India (PAFI), Bery listed managing urbanisation, making regula-



tions consistent and continuous, adapting to disruptive technologies, managing climate change, and addressing the issue of regional imba-

"If we are to transit from the middle-income trap, the private sector needs to enhance its contribution to R&D through its own investments and under corporate social responsibility (CSR)," he said. "The investment in R&D is 1-2% of the GDP with a huge part of it coming from the government... The private sector contributes less than 40% to the annual R&D spend compared to over 70% that they contribute in advanced countries," Bery said. He called upon the private sector to collaborate with the government to be part of the National Rese-

lances as key challenges faced by the country.

Reiterating that India has the advantage of largest arable land and the largest population of bovine animals, Bery said raising agricultural productivity and having opportunities for displaced labour is a big challenge.
